PASTOR'S MESSAGE: PROPHETS

Prophets are people who speak on behalf of God. Their visions and oracles often sound harsh because it is the voice of a loving God who is warning or condemning those who have gone astray. Yet, prophets also speak words of hope and comfort to those who feel dejected or sorrowful because of the difficulties they face. God's anger expressed through the prophets reveals his desire to set things right. It shows God's relationship with humanity is personal.

Prophets are also intermediaries between God and humans straddling two worlds. They represent God and relay God's message to people. They can also act as intercessors, pleading on behalf of humans for blessings or the avoidance of punishment. Sometimes prophets have predicted how God will act in the future., often the near future.

John the Baptist was in many ways the last of the Hebrew Scripture (Old Testament) prophets and the first of those in Christian Scripture (New Testament). His words warned people about their sinfulness and need for conversion. Yet, he also gave them hope by pointing towards a new future in which they would encounter God's Kingdom in a direct way. The urgency of his message made it clear action must be taken now: prepare in concrete ways for the future before it was too late.
