From the Bishop's Desk

In the area of the moral issues of our day, it often seems like we are fighting a losing battle. On Wednesday, June 17, we received a little good news for a change. The Special Joint Parliamentary Committee on Medical Assistance in Dying issued its report regarding expanding MAID eligibility to include those individuals whose sole underlying medical condition is a mental illness. The committee recommended not expanding MAID to include this most vulnerable group. Although the numbers of those requesting MAID continue to rise in our country, this decision is welcomed news. We pray that our current government follows the recommendation of this parliamentary committee. The expectation is that the Prime Minister will table legislation halting expansion, which was previously scheduled for March 17, 2027.
